#### **Role Description Basketball Assistant Coach:**

- Develop in conjunction with the Basketball Head coach a skills based acquisition and training curriculum for the Basketball program
- As a part of the coaching team deliver the skills based acquisition and training curriculum in line with coaching and development standards outlined by Basketball NSW
- Deliver skill acquisition and training sessions which are planned and sequential for the Basketball program from 8:15am to 9:45am on a Tuesday and Thursday morning throughout the school term. (3 hours total per week)
- Work with the Head Coach and Sports Organiser (Teacher manager) to ensure that all training sessions are student focused. All sessions are to be both enjoyable and varied
- Monitor student behaviour and standard of attire during Academy training sessions and report any issues to the Head Coach and Sports Organiser
- Promote Narrabeen Sports High School Sports Academy's Basketball Program through various Basketball networks to attract Elite Athletes to our school.
- *Essential*
  - **Club Coach Accreditation (Formerly Level 1)**
  - Suited for domestic and representative grade coaches, the Club Coach Course is the most commonly delivered course throughout NSW.
  - It is typically viewed as the entry-level basketball coaching accreditation for any coach who is interested in investing time into improving their coaching skill set.



- *Desirable*
  - **Association Coach Accreditation (Formerly Level 2)**
  - Suited for higher representative grade coaches. It is typically viewed as a level of accreditation that provides coaches with some specialised learnings from experts from various fields within basketball, for example:
    - Nutrition
    - Strength & Conditioning
    - Communication & Leadership
    - Pick & Roll Offense and Defence
    - Basketball Australia Style of Play
    - Game Scouting and Preparation
